Mrs. Zelmarine Murphy, President, called the meeting to order.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

The minutes from the regular board meeting held on May 20, 2010, and the special called meetings held on May 26, 2010, were approved.

DONATIONS:

The following cash donation was approved:

- Warren Central Jr. High received \$100.00 each from Betty Whitaker and Dollie Harrison. The funds will be used for student incentives.

FINANCIAL:

- Dale McClung presented the financial update.
- The Board adopted the 2010-2011 budget.
- Amendments to the 2009-2010 budget were approved.
- The accounts payable claims docket for the month of June 2010, was approved.

SIXTEENTH SECTION LAND:

- Bids were approved for hunting and fishing leases on South Park, Dana Road, and Davis Island.
- The Board granted permission to advertise for a hunting and fishing lease on Section 16-T18-R5E (Ballground).
- Bids were opened for oil, gas, and mineral lease on Eagle Lake. The bid was awarded to Lawco Exploration.
- Bovina Volunteer Fire Department requested a temporary construction easement. The request was approved pending certain requirements.

OUT OF STATE TRAVEL:

The Board approved the following out of state travel request:

- Warren Central Jr. High requested permission for Cedric Magee to attend the Harvard Institute for school leadership at Harvard University in Cambridge, Massachusetts on July 6-12, 2010.
- Warren Central High School requested permission for Robert A. Hodges to attend the in-service training in Pensacola, Florida on July 6-8, 2010, and new instructor training in San Diego, California on July 20-22, 2010.
- Sherrie Williams requested permission to attend the National Safe Schools/Healthy Students Conference for FY 2010 SS/HS grantees.

PROPOSALS/BIDS:

- The Board approved the drivers education vehicle lease submitted by Blackburn Motor Company. The bid was \$419/month for midsize; \$469/month for full size; and \$.15 per mile for miles over 7,000.
- The Board rejected the bid for diesel fuel from Petroleum Traders.
- No bids were received for surplus property.

DISPOSAL OF RECORDS:

SINGLE SOURCE PURCHASE:

Project SYNC requested permission to purchase AI's Pals curriculum kits and training from Wingspan, which is the sole source supplier of these materials. The cost is \$30,337.50.

BOND REFUNDING:

- The Board approved the agreement for general obligation for refunding bonds.
