Who can apply?

- High school seniors
- Current college students
- County employees taking college courses
- County employees' spouses taking college courses

Eligibility:

- Applicant must provide a Sponsor who is currently employed by or retired from Mississippi county government; however, Sponsor cannot be an elected official (currently serving or retired). Sponsor may be:
 - Applicant
 - Applicant's spouse
 - Applicant's immediate family member (parent, stepparent, grandparent, step-grandparent or legal guardian)
- Be a legal resident of Mississippi
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.5
- Must be enrolled (or will enroll) in an accredited, public Mississippi college, junior or community college, or university in the Fall (August) 2019 semester

Requirements:

- Complete the 2019 County Employee Scholarship application
- Provide a letter or transcript (not official) on school letterhead proving student's current GPA
- Provide a letter on county letterhead proving employment or retirement of Sponsor
- Write an essay (up to 750 words) on the assigned topic (see application form)
